Alfredo Jaar is an acclaimed artist, sculptor, and photographer whose installations and powerful works have been exhibited in solo and group shows throughout the world (including 2002's *Documenta 11* held in Kassel, Germany), and at art institutions such as the New Museum of Contemporary Art in New York, the Museum of Contemporary Art in Chicago, and the Museum of Modern Art in Stockholm, Sweden. A native of Santiago de Chile, where he studied architecture and film direction, Jaar has been recognized with numerous awards, and is the recipient of the prestigious MacArthur Fellowship.

David Levi Strauss is a critic and writer whose book of essays on art and politics, *Between Dog & Wolf*, has just been published by Autonomedia/Semiotext(e). His essays and reviews appear regularly in *The Nation* and *Artforum*, and his writings have been included in books on artists that include Martin Puryear and Alfredo Jaar. Mr. Levi Strauss was a 2003 Guggenheim Fellow, and he has been the recipient of such awards as a Logan grant, and three Artspace grants. He has taught and lectured at a number of colleges and universities on both coasts.
