The lecture is entitled ***Grotesque: The Emergence of Modernism in the Art of German Speaking Europe 1870-1905***. The event is part of SITE's Fifth International Biennial exhibition's *Art & Culture* series. Pamela Kort is an independent curator and art historian specializing in twentieth-century art in German-speaking Europe. She holds MA and PhD degrees in Art History from the University of California at Los Angeles. She has served as Associate Curator, Schirn Kunsthalle Frankfurt, Germany (2001-03) and Associate Curator, Neue Galerie, New York: Museum for German and Austrian Art (2000-01). She lives in Berlin.

This program is designed to provide an art historical context and reference for *Disparities and Deformations: Our Grotesque*, SITE Santa Fe's Fifth International Biennial exhibition curated by Robert Storr. Kort curated the exhibition *Grotesque! 130 Years of Witty Art* for the Schirn Kunsthalle Frankfurt and the Haus der Kunst, Munich in June-September 2003.

In contrast to Storr's exhibition, this exhibition focused substantially on tracing historical works through an alternative modernism, which represented the subversive power and wit of the grotesque through humor and comedic elements.

A limited number of free tickets will be made available on a first-come, first-serve basis to students with ID at the door.

SITE Santa Fe is located at 1606 Paseo de Peralta, Santa Fe, New Mexico. Summer exhibition hours are Wednesday through Saturday, 10:00 am–6:00 pm; Friday, 10:00 am–7:00 pm; Sunday, noon–6 pm, through September 5, 2004. Admission is \$8.00 for adults and \$4 for students and seniors; members are free. Free admission is offered on Fridays, made possible by a grant from The Brown Foundation, Inc., Houston.
