Santa Fe, NM – **SITE Santa Fe's Young Curators and The Darkroom** are pleased to present the tenth annual juried youth photography exhibition, entitled *Unborn Revolutions*, which will be on view at the Museum of Fine Arts from April 15 – June 12, 2005. The public is invited to an **opening reception with the artists and Young Curators** on Friday, April 15, 2005, from 5:00 – 7:00 pm at the Museum of Fine Arts, 107 West Palace Avenue. Refreshments will be served.

Unborn Revolutions highlights innovative, intelligent, and startling new works by New Mexico high school and college-aged artists. The call for entries was marked by a diverse and impressive outpouring of submissions. *Unborn Revolutions* includes photography, mixed media works, and installations that address social, political, and personal revolutions. \$700 in cash awards will be given to first, second, and third place winners for high school and college categories.

The Young Curators is a weekly after-school and summer program for high school students developed and facilitated by SITE Santa Fe's Education Department. The program's primary goals are to encourage teenagers' connection to contemporary art and provide a context for an exploration of the structure and production of exhibitions. The Young Curators learn the skills and procedures necessary for creating an exhibition and challenge audiences to re-examine their ideas regarding youth art exhibitions by encouraging critical thinking about the role of art in society at large and the local community in particular.
