Santa Fe, NM, November 24, 2010 - SITE Santa Fe, the Southwest's premier not-for-profit, non-collecting contemporary arts organization, has named **Charles Webster** of Fort Worth, Texas to its board of directors.

For more than 40 years, Charles has been active in the cultural community, serving on the boards of several arts institutions including, The Fort Worth Symphony and Opera and The Modern Art Museum of Fort Worth.
